### **DMWS Goes to the Bulls**

Please join DMWS families for a fun group outing on Sunday, April 22. The game begins at 5 p.m., and after the game, kids can run the bases! Tickets cost \$6 each; DMWS earns 25% of each ticket sold. DMWS families will be able to sit as a group in the Diamond View section—which is in close proximity to the obstacle course and speed pitch. We hope to see you there!
